NUMBERS WILL BE ASSIGNED TO ATHLETES, AND SENT TO PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS SO NUMBERS CAN BE WRITTEN ON COMPETITORS HANDS IN ADVANCE OF THE MEET. ATHLETES WILL SIMPLY REPORT FOR EVENTS TO EITHER THE ASSEMBLY CLERK OR FIELD EVENT JUDGE. THE ANCHOR FOR EACH RELAY MUST WEAR A STICKER WITH THE NAME OF ALL FOUR RUNNERS.

- 1. The meet has been sanctioned by the SDHSAA as a qualifying meet with boys and girls divisions. There will be a <u>coaches meeting at 3:15 p.m. near the finish line</u>.
- 2. The entry fee is \$100.00. Entries are unlimited for all individual events except the long, triple jumps which are limited to five, and the shot put and discus which are limited to six, and each school may enter two teams per relay event.
- 3. The first heat is the "fast" heat for track events. Coaches will determine the terms flights, finals, starting heights, etc. for the field events. <u>The throwing implements must be weighed and marked in the equipment room of the building at the east end of the facility by 3:15 p.m.</u> Poles will also be checked at the event as per SDHSAA regulations.
- 4. A schedule of events is attached. The throw pads are concrete. The runways and high jump area are all weather surfaces. Maximum spike length is 1/8" pyramid (no needle spikes).
- 5. Mark Wendelgass will be the meet referee and Steve Charron will be the starter.
- 6. Coaches are encouraged to review the SDHSAA Track & Field Regulations with their athletes prior to the meet (i.e. conduct rules, lane infractions, interference, etc.). Most of the inspectors have experience working the State Track Meet and will report possible infractions.
- 7. Spectators will not be allowed in the competition areas.
- 8. Medals will be awarded in the individual events and will be awarded to the members of winning relay teams. Medals should be picked up in the press box <u>by a coach at the conclusion of the meet</u>.
- 9. Team points will not be kept. Individual results will be e-mailed to the SDHSAA, media, head coaches and athletic directors from the press box at the conclusion of the meet.
- 10. Team camps will be located outside the fence on the east side of the facility (near the pole vault area). Please make sure that your area is cleaned before leaving.
- 11. Angela Brown, ATC will be on duty. There are team rest rooms and a training room in the BHS Sports Complex. Concessions will be available below the stadium seating.
- 12. Ticket prices are \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students. Must have a voucher
