BROOKINGS SCHOOL DISTRICT COVID-19 SPECTATOR AND GAME USEGAE PLAN FOR HIGH SCHOOL TRACK MEET AT BROOKINGS HIGH SCHOOL

Spectators – General Information:

- The Brookings School District will be taking steps to limit spectator attendance at our activities this fall. The premise of limiting attendance is based on these three goals:
 1. Keep all students and staff safe.
 2. Keep all students and staff in school as long as possible.
 3. Give all students the opportunity to participate in activities.
- The Brookings School District believes limiting spectator attendance provides our students the best opportunity to complete their seasons and reduces the likelihood of community transmission.
- Brookings High School will follow the events protocols, and will provide workers to help manage the safety of all spectators, participants, and workers.
- No tailgating or pre-game activities allowed in parking lots
- **Masks are mandatory for ALL spectators' at ALL INDOOR events on Brookings School District Property. Masks for OUTDOOR events will be mandatory when you are not sitting in your family unit, cannot social distance, visiting the restrooms and concessions or inside any Brookings Facility.**
- Spectators are asked to socially distance themselves away from those not in their immediate families to the best of their ability. Spectators will be mandated to seat in Family Units with the 3 they have vouchers for.
- No Reentry at any event that requires vouchers.
- **Please note: ONLY those individuals who possess an event & date specific voucher will be allowed in.**
- This Brookings School District COVID-19 spectator attendance plan is subject to change at any time and will be reevaluated during the fall season.
- Pre-meet COVID script will be read
- Ticket booths and gates open one hour prior to the game. (Map 1)
- Spectators will use the ticket booth to purchase tickets.
- Spectators will be directed to park on the west side of the High School. (Map 1)
- We will have a concession stands

Team Info:

- Bus Drop Off and Parking – The visiting team can drop off athletes and coaches at the field and park in the Southwest parking lot. (Map 1))
- **Masks are required by all Team Personnel. Athletes will not have to wear masks when they are warming up or participating.**
- Water – BHS Trainers will aid visiting team to fill water containers for team's usage. Each team will provide their own watering containers and personnel to manage.
- BHS will provide athletic training – **Angela Brown** – during the event, Please inform us if you will be bringing an Athletic Trainer or Team Doctor.

Voucher and Entry Requirements:

- Each rostered person (athlete/manager/statistician/cheerleader/coach/administrator) will be given three (3) event & date specific vouchers to distribute as they wish. The voucher does not grant admission, but rather allows the holder to purchase a ticket to get into the specific game listed on the voucher. *(Please note vouchers will NOT be reissued).* The visiting school's Activities Director will be emailed the same number of total event & date specific vouchers as Brookings High School is providing to its own teams for each event.
- Any student, parent, fan who enters the event, MUST remain seated with the family unit they came with.
- The only people that can purchase tickets to the game are people that have vouchers, they will give their voucher to a ticket seller, and the seller will allow them to buy a ticket.
